Structured faculty surveys to gather feedback on curriculum and resources.

C. Alumni

- Alumni surveys to understand program relevance and career impact.
- Feedback via alumni networks on employability, skill development, and lifelong learning needs.

D. External Stakeholders (Employers/Industry Experts)

 Feedback to be taken from employers/industry professionals to gain insights into the relevance and applicability of the curriculum to current industry standards and job market needs.
